2 19-01-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is accused in connection with Rajiv Nagar P.S. Case No. 237 of 2016 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of the Public Damage Property Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, in fact, petitioner, who is the labourer was engaged to do the work by landowner, Sujit Kumar, but he has falsely been implicated in this case due to misconception. It is further submitted that petitioner has no criminal antecedent and is in custody since 20.11.2016.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of the case, the petitioner above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand)



with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the
A.C.J.M., Patna, in connection with Rajiv Nagar P.S. Case No.
237 of 2016. Out of two sureties, one surety must be the close
relative of the petitioner.
