ORAL ORDER

2 20-01-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel representing the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Rajepur P.S.
Case No. 106 of 2016 registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 272, 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections
47A/53©/54 of Bihar Excise Amendment Act, 2016.

Allegedly, from the hut of the petitioner four empty
bottles of foreign liquor each of 180 ml. and one bottle containing
60 ml. foreign wine were recovered and the petitioner was
apprehended. He is in custody since 14.11.2016.

Learned APP opposes the prayer of bail.

In the facts and circumstances stated above, considering
the period of detention, the petitioner above named is directed to
be released on bail on execution of bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten



thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari in connection with Rajepur P.S. Case No. 106 of 2016, subject to the conditions that one of the bailors must be a near relative and another having sufficient immovable property within the territorial jurisdiction of the court concerned and the petitioner shall remain present on each and every date during trial and the default on two consecutive dates on his part without any reason shall disentitle the petitioner from privilege of bail.
