2 18-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned APP for the State.

Petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 302/201/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

The victim-daughter of the informant was
married with co-accused Munna Chaudhary in the year 2006.
There is allegation that the in-laws were demanding money to
clear the bank loans in respect of vehicle purchased in the family
and on non-fulfilment, she was done to death.

Submission is that husband is already in custody.
The allegation is general and omnibus and presumption of dowry
death is not there against the petitioners nor there is any eye-
witness of the occurrence.



Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur at Ara/successor Court in connection with Agion Bazar Police Station Case No. 63 of 2016.
