Seeking exception to an order dated 20th of October,
2014 passed by the learned Writ Court in C.W.J.C. No.3219 of 2014,
this appeal has been filed under Clause 10 of the Letters Patent.

Petitioner sought compassionate appointment after the
death of his father which took place way back in the year 2007.
Finding that as per the policy of the Department for grant of
compassionate appointment, compassionate appointment in the
Department can only be made on the post of Panchayat teacher or



Block Teacher and finding that the petitioner does not have the qualification necessary for appointment on the said post and further finding that after more than seven years compassionate appointment cannot be granted, the writ petition has been dismissed.

In doing so, we are of the considered view, the learned Writ Court has not committed any error warranting re-consideration.

The appeal is, therefore, dismissed.
