ORAL ORDER

2 27-02-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

This is an application for bail in connection with
Suryagarha P.S.Case No. 12 of 2017 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 272, 273, 290 of the Indian Penal Code
and 30(a), 32(c) and 38(d) of Bihar Excise (Amendment) Act,
2016.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
petitioner has clean antecedent and allegation against him is of
recovery of 19 litres of foreign liquor and he is in custody for
more than one month.

Heard learned APP also.

Having heard both sides and considering the fact that
petitioner has clean antecedent and has remained in custody for
one and a half months, let the petitioner, above named, be released



on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lakhisarai, in connection with Suryagarha P.S.Case No. 12 of 2017, subject to the conditions that :-

(i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable properties within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.

(ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.

(iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reason, the prosecution is free to move the cancellation of his bail.
