It is submitted that on behalf of the petitioner and  
opposite party no.2 that in terms of order dated 18.05.2017  
permanent alimony of Rs. 1,00000/- (one lac) has already been  
deposited in the account of opposite party no.2 and, as such,  
provisional bail granted should be confirmed.
