ORAL ORDER

3 19-04-2017 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

This is a petition for grant of regular bail for offences under Sections 302 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners are under suspicion to have committed murder of the husband of the informant for the reason that death, for dowry was committed of the sister of the deceased and the petitioners and others were pressurizing for compromise of the case.

Considering the fact that there is very weak evidence against the petitioners, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each with



two sureties of the like amount each in connection with **Kadamkuan P.S. Case No. 261 of 2010** to the satisfaction of **Sri Madhevendra Singh, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Patna**, or successor Court.
