Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the show-cause was filed but the same is not available. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted a photo copy of the show-cause, which is taken on record.

In the show-cause filed on behalf of Respondent Nos. 3, 4 and 5 it is stated that a sum of Rs. 57,234/- has been paid to the petitioner but in respect of refund of security, the petitioner has been



paid an amount of Rs. 17,161/- in excess against running bills as against the security amount of Rs. 17,170/- and, therefore, only Rs. 9/- is refundable to the petitioner.

Since the amount refundable is meager, I do not find that any useful purpose will be served to keep the Contempt Petition pending. The same is disposed of having rendered infructuous.
