8 07-12-2017 Keeping in view the counter affidavit filed on behalf of Tilka Manjhi Bhagalpur University, Bhagalpur by Shri Arvind Kumar Sharma, the Liaison Officer of the University, we find that most of the claims of the appellant has been allowed and now in the light of the aforesaid, no indulgence in this appeal is called for. However, in case the appellant's any grievance still subsists with regard to settlement of his claim, he is granted liberty to represent again before the University. The University to examine his



remaining claim and thereafter, in case, any grievance subsists, he may take recourse to such procedure, as may be permissible under the law.

The appeal stands disposed of.
