ORAL ORDER

5 09-10-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the respondents.

In the present writ application, the petitioner has sought
for the engagement as a 'Prerak' under 'Sakshar Bharat-2012,
which is a Central Scheme, for the purpose of motivating the
children for going to School. The post of 'Prerak' is not
substantive post under the State or its instrumentality, rather the



same is a kind of engagement under the Scheme carried out by the State Government. Such engagement is contractual in nature and the same is not made under any Statute, hence, no statutory right of appointment has accrued in favour of the petitioner.

I find no merit in the present writ application. The same is dismissed.

If the petitioner, so advised, may approach before the respondent no. 3, the Collector, Aurangabad. If any such representation is made on behalf of the petitioner, the same be disposed of by the respondent no. 3 preferably within a period of six months from the date of filing of such representation
