4 20-04-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

Petitioners are in custody since 01.12.2016 in connection
with Hajipur Town P.S. Case No. 705 of 2015 registered under
Sections 304(B), 201, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the
petitioner No.1, who is brother-in-law of the deceased and the petitioner
No.2 happens to be Gotni of the deceased are innocent and has not
committed any offence. In fact, there is general and omnibus allegation
against the petitioners and no specific overt act is attributed to them.
Nothing has been stated against these petitioners by the father of the
deceased rather the entire case has been lodged by the uncle of the
deceased. The petitioners are rotting in custody for the last four months.



Considering the nature of accusation, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand rupees only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Hajipur at Vaishali in connection with Hajipur Town P.S. Case No. 705 of 2015.
