ORAL ORDER

2 20-02-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Araria (Mahila) P.S. Case No. 90 of 2016 registered under Section
498A, 323, 379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that no specific allegation of overt act has been alleged
against the petitioner. In fact with the same allegations, informant
had earlier lodged a case against this petitioner, which shows the
ill and ulterior motive of the informant. In the aforesaid case,
petitioner has been granted anticipatory bail.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the
case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the



event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Araria in connection with Araria (Mahila) P.S. Case No. 90 of 2016 subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
