The learned trial court has reported that the case is pending for recording the defence evidence meaning thereby, the prosecution has already closed its evidence.

Earlier, the prayer for bail of the petitioner was twice rejected by this Court directing the trial court to dispose of the trial of the petitioner within certain period of time but, admittedly, upto now, the trial of the petitioner could not be concluded. Again, the learned Additional Sessions Judge-II, Saharsa, has sought for two months time for disposal of the case.

Since all the prosecution witnesses appears to have already been examined and petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent, I think it proper to release the petitioner on bail and, accordingly, let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing



bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge-I, Saharsa in connection with Session Trail no. 34 of 2016 arising out of Bangaon P.S. Case No. 93 of 2015.
