Inter alia, contending that an order passed on 30th April, 2007 in CWJC No. 8079 of 2005 by the learned Writ Court this application has been filed for initiating action for contempt.

It is an admitted position that in compliance to the order passed the dues payable to the petitioner have been paid. However, the petitioner seeks interest on the amount paid.

Learned counsel for the respondents argued that the petitioner is not entitled for any interest and there being no specific order directing for payment of interest no further indulgence is called for.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, I am of the considered view that now in view of the compliance made by the respondents no further indulgence into the matter is called for. In



case the petitioner is really entitled to any further interest he has the liberty to claim the same in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid, finding no reason to make interference into the matter, this application stands disposed of.
