2 09-05-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the

offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 354(A), 363 and

366(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is of kidnapping to the daughter of the

informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that

co-accused Mannu Sahani has been allowed bail by the learned

Sessions Judge, Darbhanga itself for the reason that the record

revealed that the matter is of elopement and not of kidnapping.

Allegation against the petitioner is similar to Mannu Sahani.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner,



above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 3rd Additional Sessions Judge, Darbhanga/successor Court in connection with Sessions Trial No. 10 of 2017, Regd. No. 1610 of 2016 arising out of Bishanpur Police Station Case No. 47 of 2016, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
