7 13-11-2017 Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present application with liberty to prefer an appeal before the State Appellate Authority against the order dated 28.07.2010 passed in Appeal No.157/09 by the District Teachers Employment Appellate Authority, Bhojpur at Ara.

Permission is accorded.

The petitioner shall file an appeal before the State Appellate Authority within a period of thirty days and the same shall be disposed of within the statutory period.



It has further been pointed out on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner was granted interim protection vide order dated 02.12.2011.
