Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

This is an application for bail in connection with Raghunathpur P.S.Case No. 07 of 2017 registered for the offences punishable under Section 304 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he administered injection to son of the informant and thereafter he died.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he is in custody for six months.

Heard learned APP also.

Having heard both sides and from perusal of the report of FSL, which has been called for, it appears that no Metallic, Alkaloidal, Glycosidal, Pesticidal or Volatile Poison



could be detected and in such view of the matter, let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-VIII, Siwan, in connection with Raghunathpur P.S.Case No. 07 of 2017, subject to the conditions that :-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable properties within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reason, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.
