3 25-07-2017 The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with

Hajipur Sadar P.S. Case No. 94 of 2017, registered for offences

punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 354, 379, 504 and

341 of Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of Arms Act.

Allegation against the petitioner and other co-accused
person is of assault on the informant by means of *kulhari* (axe).

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he
has falsely been implicated in this case. Moreover, injuries caused
on the person of informant was found to be simple in nature,
which will appear from the case diary and in para -37 of the case
diary, witness has submitted that brother of the informant got
injured due to fall on the ground. Further petitioner has no
criminal antecedent and has been in judicial custody
since 19.03.2017.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Vaishali (Hajipur) in connection with Hajipur SAdar P.S. Case No. 94 of 2017, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution will be free to move for cancellation of his bail bonds.
