Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

This is an application for bail in connection with
Gogri P.S.Case No. 19 of 2017 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 363 and 365 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner is named in the FIR and allegation is of
kidnapping the daughter of the informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
in her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. the victim has not
stated anything specific against the petitioner and he in custody for
about four months having clean antecedent.

Heard learned APP also, who could not controvert the
above submission.

Having heard both sides and considering the aforesaid



facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Brajesh Kumar, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Khagaria, in connection with Gogri P.S.Case No. 19 of 2017, G.R.No. 125 of 2017, subject to the conditions that :-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable properties within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reason, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail.
