3. 18-01-2017 Heard Sri Bhaskar Shankar, learned counsel for the  
petitioner and Sri Damodar Prasad Tiwary, learned Addl. Public  
Prosecutor.

This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> attempt for grant of bail on behalf of  
petitioner in Sessions Trial No. 241 of 2016, arising out of Bheldi  
P.S. Case No. 77 of 2014, registered for offence under Sections  
304(B), 34 of the Indian Penal Code. The petitioner, husband of  
the deceased, is in custody since 04-12-2015.

In this case, earlier a report was called for from the  
court below regarding stage of the case, which has been received  
and kept at flag 'B'. The report dated 22-12-2016 sent by learned  
Addl. Sessions Judge-X, Saran at Chapra makes it clear that out of  
8 chargesheeted witnesses, 5 witnesses have already been



examined and in respect of remaining witnesses, summon and warrant have also been issued.

Considering the fact that trial is going on expeditiously, there is no reason to review my earlier order.

The prayer for bail again stands rejected.

However, while dismissing, the Court expects that learned Trial Judge may take appropriate step so that the case may come to its logical end without unnecessary delay.
