The petitioners are in custody in connection with

Rupaspur P.S. Case No. 201 of 2016 for the offences under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-b) a/26/35 of the Arms Act.

Although the petitioners are accused in other cases as stated in para-3 of the petition but the fact remains that the petitioners are in jail since 2.10.2016 and no objectionable article was recovered from their conscious or physical possession.
