2 06-03-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offences punishable under Sections 304B/120B/210 of the Indian
Penal Code.

Marriage of the victim was solemnized with the
petitioner in the year 2006 and allegation is that the victim was
done to death for non-fulfilment of dowry demand in the year
2014.

Submission is that there is no presumption of
dowry death against the petitioner as she died after more than
seven years of her marriage and there is no eyewitness of the
occurrence.



Considering the aforesaid facts, let petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, West Muzaffarpur/Successor Court, in connection with Kanti P.S. Case No.203 of 2014.
