2 13-06-2017 Heard Sri Raj Kumar, learned counsel for the
petitioner, and Sri Ram Priya Saran Singh, learned A.P.P. for the
State.

The petitioner is seeking bail in Nagar (Nawada) P.S.
Case No. 200 of 2017 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149,
341, 323, 307, 353, 188, 283, 337, 153-A and 427 of the Indian
Penal Code, Section 27 of the Arms Act and Sections 3 / 4 of the
Explosive Substance Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a bare
perusal of the First Information Report would show that on the
occasion of the religious ceremony persons of two communities
indulged in free-fight. Some of the persons were arrested by police
while maintaining law and order in the alleged place of
occurrence. He further submits that similarly situated co-accused



has been granted regular bail in Cr. Misc. No. 25354/2017. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the nature of allegations as also the fact that a co-accused has been granted regular bail, let the petitioner, namely, Pankaj Kumar be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nawada in Nagar (Nawada) P.S. Case No. 200 of 2017.
