ORAL ORDER

3 31-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

Petitioner is accused in connection with Ujiarpur P.S. Case No. 11 of 2017 registered under Sections 272/273 of the I.P.C. and 30(a)/47 of the Bihar Prohibition of Liquor and Excise Act.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner, who happens to be the owner of the vehicle, has falsely been implicated in this case. Moreover, petitioner is in custody since 22.01.2017.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody of the petitioner, let the above



named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional District and Sessions Judge-VI, Samastipur in connection with Sessions Trial No. 406 of 2017 arising out of Ujiarpur P.S. Case No. 11 of 2017.
