3 01-03-2017 Heard both sides.

The petitioner seeks bail in Shahpur P.S. case No. 199 of 2016 under Section 307, 341/34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 27 of the Arms Act.

The petitioner is alleged to have fired on the left thigh of informant. The projective passed through. The doctor found two injures and both the injuries are communicating to each other. It is opined that the injury is grievous in nature as middle part of thigh bone was found cracked.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in a fit of anger the firing was made which hit on non vital part of the body. The petitioner is in jail since 10.08.2016. The petitioner has already remained in jail for about seven months.



Considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioner and the fact that petitioner has already remained in jail for about seven months, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-XIV, Bhojpur, Ara in Shahpur P.S. Case No. 199 of 2016.
