ORAL ORDER

3 17-07-2017 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Shashtri Nagar P.S.Case No.185 of 2017 registered for offences
punishable under Sections 420/120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that duplicate H.P.
Cartridges were recovered from the shop of the petitioner and the
case is under Section 420, 120B of the I.P.C. and Section 51/63 of
Copy Right Act.

Submission of the learned counsel for petitioner is
that he has repairing shop of the computer machine, as such he
was refilling the H.P. cartridges but he had no knowledge that
these are duplicate cartridges and further he is in custody for about
three months. The petitioner is ready to abide by any condition



imposed upon him, if he is granted bail.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M., Patna District- Patna in connection with Shastri Nagar P.S.Case No.185 of 2017.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reason, otherwise, his bail bond shall be cancelled.
- (iv) If his active participation is found in such type of cases in future, his bail bond shall be cancelled.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
