the petitioner.

No one appears for the State.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in Bibhutipur
P.S. Case No. 62 of 2017 under Sections 30A, 38(1), (2) and 47 of
the Bihar Excise and Prohibition act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
allegation against the present petitioner is that he was showing
way riding his bicycle to the vehicles on which the alleged foreign
liquors were being transported. He would further submit that there
is no recovery / seizure from his motorcycle or from his conscious
possession. The allegations are false, the petitioner has no criminal
antecedent and has surrendered himself on 28.03.2017.

Considering the facts and circumstances as also the



submissions of the petitioner, let the petitioner, namely, Ram Sogarth Singh be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Rosera, District – Samastipur in Bibhutipur P.S. Case No. 62 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 437(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
