3. 28-01-2017 Ofcourse, the matter has been listed under the heading “For Orders (On Office Notes)”, which suggests that there were certain defects in the petition, on examining the record of C.W.J.C. No. 5561 of 2011, for which restoration has been sought for, it is evident that the writ petition was not dismissed only on the ground of non-prosecution, but a Bench of this Court by a detailed order dated 26-09-2014 considering the merit of the case has rejected the same, whereas, in the present petition, which has been filed for restoration of the writ petition, it has been indicated
