Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
offences under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code
and Section 30(A) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act,
2016.

It is contended that as per allegation, 214 bottles
of Nepali litchi wine each containing 300 ml and 89 bottles each
containing 300 ml of Nepali soufi wine were recovered which
were being carried by two persons in a gunny bag who tried to
escape seeing the police party but one of them was apprehended
on chase who disclosed the name of the petitioner. Petitioner
claims that he is having clean antecedent and is in custody since



15.03.2017.

Considering the facts and the circumstances of the case, the petitioner, abovenamed is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-VII-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Mahuawa (Chhaurandano) P.S. Case No. 46 of 2017 with a condition that if the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found to be involved in criminal case of similar nature, the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bonds.
