Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for
offences punishable under Sections 272, 273/74 of the Indian
Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, about 42 liters
of Nepali Soufi wine were recovered from the possession of
the petitioners. Petitioners claim their antecedent to be clean
and they are in custody since 14.05.2017.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the
case, the petitioners, above-named, are directed to be



released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Raxaul at Motihari in connection with Chhauradano (Mahuawa) P.S. Case No.108 /2017.

Further, if the petitioners, after their release in this case, are again found to be involved in criminal case of similar nature, the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of their bail bonds.
