2 26-07-2017 The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with

Daraunda P.S. Case No. 71 of 2017, registered for offences

punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 307, 151,

152, 353 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner that he along with

several other co accused persons obstructed the police officials in

discharge of their duty and also assaulted them.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that no

allegation of assault has been levelled against the petitioner and he

can only be said to be the member of mob. Further he has been in

judicial custody since 29.04.2017.

Learned counsel for the State could not controvert the

above submission.

Having heard both sides, in view of the facts as stated

above, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on



furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM- XI, Siwan, in connection with Daraunda P.S. Case No. 71 of 2017, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution will be free to move for cancellation of his bail bonds.
