3 21-09-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 23.05.2017 in
connection with Belhar P.S. Case No.108A of 2015 (G.R.
No.1181/15) registered for the offence under Sections 147,
148, 149, 387, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section
27 of the Arms Act, Sections 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22 of
C.L.A Act and Section 9(x), 13 of the U.A.P. Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is not named in the F.I.R., rather his name has
surfaced on the confessional statement of Indradeo Yadav,
which has got no evidentiary value. Learned counsel further
submits that nothing has been recovered from his conscious



possession and he has not yet been put on T.I. Parade.

In the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka, in connection with Belhar P.S. Case No.108A of 2015 (G.R. No.1181/15).
