ORAL ORDER

2 10-08-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for offence punishable under Sections 272, 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30 (a)/47 of Bihar Excise Amendment Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 414 liters of foreign liquor were recovered from a Pick-up Van. The petitioner is a Driver of the said van. It is urged that the petitioner is in custody since 23.01.2017. It is claimed that his antecedent is clean.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge, VI, Samastipur in connection with



Sessions Trial No.406/2017 arising out of Ujiyarpur P.S. Case No.11/2017 with a condition that if the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bonds.
