The appeal is dismissed. The Court refuses to interfere with the order dated 05.07.2013 because it is left open to the appellate authorities itself to take a decision on the observation made by the learned single Judge. They are free to decide the matter. If there are certain suppression of facts, which has been submitted at the bar, then the proper remedy should have been a review application instead of an appeal.



The appeal has no merit. It is dismissed. The State authorities are free to decide.
