2 26-07-2017 The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with

Banka P.S. Case No. 515 of 2016, registered for offences

punishable under Section 395 and 395 of the Indian Penal Code.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he

has falsely been implicated in this case and has been dragged in

this case only on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused

and has been languishing in judicial custody since 26.09.2016.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, from perusal of record, it

appears that the case relates to bank dacoity of Rs. 3,96,000/- and

from the house of the petitioner cash and other looted articles were

recovered, considering these facts, I am not inclined to release the

petitioner on bail, his application for regular bail is, accordingly,



rejected.

However, since the petitioner has been in judicial custody since 29.06.2016, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial and try to conclude it within a period of one year.

At the same time S.P. Banka, is also directed to ensure the production of witnesses in the court on the date fixed so that the trial can be concluded within the aforesaid period.
