this Court by order dated 13.4.2017 passed in Cr.Misc.No. 17216

framing of charge in this case.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that

now charge has been framed and there is no allegation of rape

against the petitioner as when mother of victim girl came he fled

away and he is in custody for more than eight months.

circumstances, let petitioner, above named, be released on bail on

furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand)

Additional Sessions Judge-I, Patna, in connection with Special (POCSO) Case No. 3 of 2017, arising out of Khagaul P.S. Case No. 2 of 2017, subject to the following conditions :-

- (1) One of the bailors shall be a local person having sufficient immovable properties within the jurisdiction of the court concerned,
