Heard the parties.

The appellant seeks regular bail in connection with
Jehanabad S.C./S.T. P.S.Case No.18 of 2017, registered for
offences punishable under Section 447, 323, 379, 427, 354, 504,
506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3(x) of SC/ST
(Prevention of Atrocities Act) Act.

Allegation against the appellant and other accused
persons is of abusing the informant by taking caste name and
against this appellant the allegation is that that he has assaulted
one Kushum Devi but the injury is simple. It further appears that
the appellant was on police bail earlier.

Heard learned Special P.P. also.

Having heard both sides in view of the above facts
and circumstances, this appeal is allowed.



Let the appellant above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000 (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge- Ist, Jehanabad in connection with Jehanabad S.C./S.T. P.S.Case No.18 of 2017 after setting aside order dated 20.7.2017 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-Ist, Jehanabad in Jehanabad S.C./S.T. P.S.Case No.18 of 2017, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the appellant shall be local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The appellant will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The appellant shall co-operate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court concerned and on the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution will be free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.
