4 15-09-2017 Heard Smt. Bela Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner
and Sri Yogendra Kumar, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor.

The sole petitioner, who is in custody since 05.06.2017 in
Paroo P.S. Case No.116/17 registered for the offence under
Sections 30(a), 38, 41, 44 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act, 2016, has prayed for grant of bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, by way of referring to
the statement made in paragraph-3 of the petition, submits that
the petitioner is having clean antecedent and on false accusation
of recovery of huge quantity of country made liquor/Indian
make foreign liquor, the petitioner was made accused.

Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer
for bail.

However, considering the nature of accusation, period of



custody as well as clean antecedent, let the petitioner, namely, Kishun Ram @ Ramkishun Ram be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 3rd Addl. Sessions Judge-cum- Special Judge, Excise, Muzaffarpur in connection with Paroo P.S. Case No.116/17.
