This is an appeal by the owner of the vehicle challenging an interlocutory order passed in a proceeding under Section 140 of the Motor Vehicles Act by which as the Insurance Company was not impleaded as a party, the interim compensation under Section 140 of the Motor Vehicles Act has been awarded against the owner.

Keeping in view the fact that the appeal is against an interim Award, the same is dismissed, as the appellant owner can



always raise the issue after the final Award is passed.

Accordingly, finding no ground to interfere at this interlocutory stage, the appeal is dismissed.
