ORAL ORDER

2 25-08-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for offence punishable under Sections 272, 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30 (a), 47 of Bihar Excise Amendment Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 711.310 liters of foreign liquor were recovered from the Pick-Up Van. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. It is urged that the petitioners are in custody since 10.06.2017. It is claimed that their antecedents are clean.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners, above-named, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand)



each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional District and Sessions Judge-VI, Samastipur in connection with Bibhutipur P.S. Case No. 131 of 2017 with a condition that if the petitioners, after their release in this case, are again found involved in similar nature of cases then the concerned court would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of their bail bonds.
