The petitioner is in custody since 26.05.2017 in connection
with a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections
323/341/504/307/326/506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27
of the Arms Act.

Considering the nature of allegation made against the
petitioner and that there was no repetition of blows and also
because the dispute has arisen only on account of petty reason
regarding irrigation of fields, let the petitioner above named, be
released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten
thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the
satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate 1st
