Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with  
Parasbigha P.S.Case No.64 of 2017 , registered for offences  
punishable under Section 366(A)of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of kidnapping the  
minor girl of the informant.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is  
that the case is under Section 366 of the Indian Penal Code and her  
statement has been recorded before the learned Magistrate in  
which she has stated that she left her house on her own will  
without any threat or persuasion.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and



circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sri Pranav Kumar Bharty, J.M. 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Jehanabad in connection with Parasbigha P.S.Case No.64 of 2017.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court. In the event of failure on his part to appear before the court below on two consecutive dates without showing any genuine reason, his bail bond shall be cancelled.

With the aforesaid observation, this application is allowed.
