3 28-01-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Section 414/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

One motorcycle was recovered from the possession
of co-accused Bishwajit Kumar. The informant-police suspected
that the same was stolen property. Bishwajit Kumar confessed
that the petitioner had supplied the same to him.

Submission of the petitioner is that Bishwajit was
accused in a murder case of one of the agnates of the petitioner
and the petitioner was a witness in the case. Just to pressurize he
falsely implicated the petitioner. Petitioner has got no criminal



antecedent. Aforesaid fact is evident from the case-diary itself.

Considering the facts aforesaid, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Dehri (Rohtas)/Successor Court in connection with Akorhigola Police Station Case No.93 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
