6 25-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

Petitioner is in custody since 04.12.2016 in connection
with Mansahi P.S. Case No. 61 of 2016 registered under Sections 302
and 201 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the
petitioner, who is of clean antecedent, is innocent and has not
committed any offence. In fact, initially the petitioner has not been
named in the F.I.R. but during course of investigation, the parents of
deceased has disclosed the name of this petitioner only on suspicion.
There is no eye witness to the alleged occurrence. Moreover, charges in
this case have been framed, which is evident from supplementary
affidavit filed on behalf of the petitioner. The petitioner is rotting in
custody for the last eight months.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand rupees only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-Vith, Katihar in connection with Mansahi P.S. Case No. 61 of 2016.
