The petitioner has questioned the legal sustainability of the
impugned order by which the learned District Judge, Siwan has turned
down the prayer of the petitioner for transfer the T.S. No. 286 of 1994
from the court of Sub Judge VIII, Siwan to any other court.

the learned court below after considering the facts and circumstances
