This Court will not interfere with the order under appeal
dated 15.07.2013 for the simple reason that the principle applied by
the learned single Judge that settled positions cannot be unsettled
after more than six or seven years of inordinate delay that too not
properly explained either before the tribunal or before the High



Court. Merely saying that representation was pending and he was pursuing the matter does not help the situation in any manner.

Appeal is dismissed being devoid of merit.
