Accordingly, petitioners Anwarul Haque @ Md. Anwarool Haque, Wasim each are directed to be released on bail



on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria in connection with Araria P.S. Case No.444/2017.
