Heard counsel for the appellant, the Patna Municipal Corporation.

The order, dated 11.04.2014, passed in C. W. J. C. No. 8517 of 2007, is under challenge.

The Learned Single Judge has gone by the precedence and allowed the writ application on the ground that the time-bound-promotion is required to be given to the petitioner, keeping in view similar orders passed, which have been dealt with in the impugned order itself.



In the opinion of this Court, precedence has been followed by the Learned Single Judge in the earlier adjudication made, which have not been challenged or set aside. Therefore, the Learned Single Judge has committed no error of law.

Appeal is dismissed.
