2 14-12-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the

learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 01.10.2017 in
connection with Telhara P.S. Case No.127 of 2017 registered
for the offences under Sections 147, 341, 323, 307, 504 and
302 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
the entire allegation is against one Bijendra Jamadar and
Kabindra Jamadar and not against the present petitioners. The
only allegation against the petitioners is that they were also
present there and did not take steps to save the deceased.

Considering the fact that no specific role has been



attributed to the present petitioners, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri S.K. Singh, learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Hilsa, Nalanda, in connection with Telhara P.S. Case No.127 of 2017.
