2 22-12-2017 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Pakribarawan P.S. Case No. 191 of 2017 instituted for the
offences under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act, 2016.

The allegation is regarding recovery of 40 litres of illicit
liquor from the joint possession of the accused persons.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case, he has a
clean antecedent and is in custody since 25.10.2017.

Considering the nature of accusation, the period of
custody already undergone and the fact that the petitioner has got a



clean antecedent, I direct the petitioner named above to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge (Excise), Nawada in connection with Pakribarawan P.S. Case No. 191 of 2017.
